CCRC Scale of Adoption

- Thank you to all who are participating!
- Consensus reports from Guided Pathways team was due March 1, 2018
- Follow up phone calls from Center staff will take place throughout March and April; Data and feedback will be used to guide the Strategic Planning process

Consulting/Coaching

- Assessment and action plans were due 2.15.18
- 12 Colleges are participating in Guided Pathways Consulting between now and September 2018
- Will have a second round – colleges may be able to continue or start with a new coach, other colleges not currently receiving coaching can also request services; stay tuned for more details

CRN IV:

- Interim reports were due March 1, 2018; state interim report is to be submitted to OSHE by the end of March
- Four colleges are receiving consulting for recruitment needs and incorporating the student success component into their CRN courses
- Eight colleges attended the National Association of Developmental Education (NADE) in February
- Eight colleges will attend the Conference on Acceleration in Developmental Education (CADE) conference in June
- Center will be putting in a proposal to share NJ's ALP model in the high schools for CRN at CADE conference
