

## Monthly Update, April 2018

### CCRC Scale of Adoption

- Thank you to all who are participating!
- Follow up phone calls from Center staff are taking place.
- Data and feedback will be used to guide the Strategic Planning process.

### Consulting/Coaching

- 12 Colleges are participating in Guided Pathways Consulting between now and September 2018.
- Will have a second round – colleges may be able to continue or start with a new coach, other colleges not currently receiving coaching can also request services; stay tuned for more details.

### CRN IV:

- Interim report was submitted to the OSHE. Expected to serve 3,036 students from 86 high schools.
- Nine colleges are using the ALP model in the high schools.
- Eight colleges will attend the Conference on Acceleration in Developmental Education (CADE) in June.
- Center's proposal to share NJ's ALP model in the high schools for CRN at CADE conference was approved. Leaders from Ocean, Mercer, Salem and Essex will be presenting with Donna.

### Center Evaluations

- Bragg & Associates completed the Center evaluation. Report will be disseminated across the state.
- Survey has gone out to all past event participants (1,179 individuals) to ascertain impact of attending an in-person or online professional development opportunity. Events beginning in October 2016 – current are being assessed.
